

Parnell Rose Gardens and Judges Bay Loop Walk



1. This walk commences on the corner of Gladstone Rd and Judges Bay Rd at the Stone archway entrance
2. Follow the driveway for about 50m and then head into the bush on the right for a short explore
3. Head back onto the driveway and then almost immediately turn right into the Nancy Steen Garden and Fountain. Toilets are opposite the Garden.
4. Follow the track downhill to Judges Bay
5. Head up the hill to St. Stephens Church and historic graveyard
6. Exit the church yard on to Judge St via the church archway
7. Walk up Judge St and turn left into St. Stephens Ave and to the reserve above the Auckland Waterfront
8. Take the stairs down to the Pedestrian bridge and at the base of the stairs take the first left and more stairs down to Parnell Baths. If you want further views venture across the bridge,
9. Follow the walkway through the Parnell Baths complex and to Judges Bay
10. Wander alongside Judges Bay, past the jetty and toilet block. Look out for the Wedge Sculpture on the grass hill on the left
11. Climb the hill back up into Dove Meyer Robinson Park and enjoy the sprawling Potukawa Trees and bush
12. There are a number of monuments through this sections, including a memorial to the Korean War
13. Head back towards Redwall Chinese Restaurant and cross to its left (Southern side) and finish your walk with a wander through the beautiful and significant Rose Garden

Rosies café is across Gladstone Rd and about 50m up the road. Redwall Chinese Restaurant is within the Rose Gardens.

A childrens Playground is across the road from the Rose Gardens.
